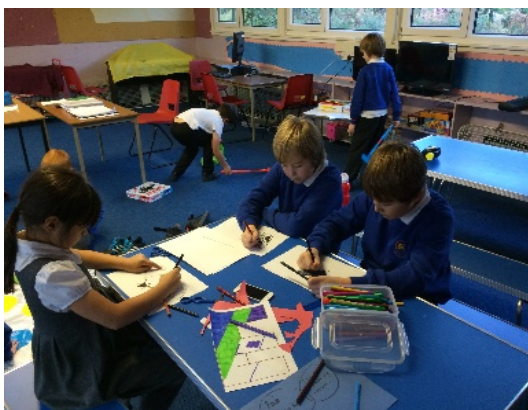
children have been busy getting the room ready for Halloween with their art work.
